

Heathmont College Council and its community are proud of our student uniform which was developed through extensive consultation with students and parents in 2011.

Students are expected to be in full College uniform at all times, including to and from school. If a student is out of uniform for any reason they must provide a note from their parents, which must be taken to their Coordinators prior to the start of the day. They will then be issued with a uniform pass for that day.

To assist in the development of student responsibility and improved student uniform the school has introduced the following supportive disciplinary measure for students who are out of uniform without parental consent.

- If any student is out of uniform for any reason, they must obtain a uniform pass from their Coordinator prior to the start of the school day.
- Students who are out of uniform without parent approval will be given a lunchtime detention on that day.
- Failure to attend the detention will mean two further lunchtime detentions.
- If a student does not attend these two detentions they will be given a whole day, in-school detention which will be held on Wednesdays.

  - Heathmont College maroon & navy Rugby Jumper.

#### GENERAL NOTES:

- All items of clothing should bear the student's name.
- Neatness and cleanliness are part of being properly dressed.
- **Leather shoes must be worn at all times as this is a Health and Safety issue, particularly in practical classes for Science, Technology and Foods.**
- Jewellery and cosmetics are not part of the College uniform and must not be worn. SOS tags and watches are permitted. The only body piercings permitted are studs and small sleepers in the ears. **No responsibility can be taken for any items brought to College or worn by students ignoring these rules.**
- Aprons (provided by the College) **MUST** be worn in Technology lessons to protect uniforms.
- The Sport uniform (as outlined above) must be worn to all PE and sport classes. Students are permitted to wear the Sport uniform for the entire school day that they have a scheduled PE class. Students are not permitted to wear the Sport uniform on days where they do not have a PE class.
- A combination of Sport and standard uniform is **not acceptable**.
